The City of Willard will be conducting a city-wide trash cleanup on Friday, April 19th and Saturday, April 20th. The City will have dumpsters placed at the northeast corner of Myrtle and Woodland. The dumpsters will be available for city residents from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on Friday and 8:00 a.m. until noon on Saturday.

Willard Residents only may use the dumpsters for general trash such as attic/garage/basement materials, furniture, TV's, boards, glass, etc. The dumpsters will be monitored, and garbage will not be accepted. Any resident that has household batteries to dispose of may recycle them at the Wastewater Treatment Plant the first Wednesday of every month between 12 noon and 1:00 p.m.

During this week (April 15th – April 19th), the City will conduct curbside pick-up of white goods such as stoves, washers, dryers, and hot water tanks. Items must be out by Friday morning.

The City has made arrangements for curbside pick up of special items that, by their nature, have an additional charge when taken to landfills. The City will pick up these items, but the resident must pay the amount charged to the City for these items. These items and the costs are:

- Refrigerators, freezers, & air conditioners - \$20.00 each (non-refundable)

Payment for pick up of these items must be made in advance at the City Hall Service Desk, Monday through Friday 8:00 am – 4:30 pm. A tag will be issued upon payment, and only those items with the proper tag will be picked up. Please note that even if the Freon is removed from an item, the \$20.00 fee (non-refundable) must still be paid for in advance.

Paint Recycling - Latex Paint only – Will be accepted at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, 7 B & O Pike on Saturday, April 20 from 9:00 am – noon.

Tire Recycling – Passenger & Light Truck Tires Only – Will be accepted at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, 7 B & O Pike on Saturday, April 20 from 9:00 am – noon. The Special Prices are as follows and must be paid at City Hall before Friday, April 20th at 4:30 pm. Residents may pay for tires at the time of drop off providing they have the exact fee.

\$5.00 on rim
